

Article Withdrawal Policy

There are no publication charges to publish with MAT Journals but to follow fair publication Principles and ethics MAT Journals do follow few article withdrawal Guidelines to check such practices.

Authors are requested to follow below mentioned guidelines if he/she wishes to withdraw submitted article:

- 1. There is no article withdrawing charges if author withdraw manuscript within a week period from the date of providing a duly signed copyright transfer form.
- 2. However, if the author withdraws manuscript any time after a week, the request will not be entertained without a withdrawal penalty.
- For withdrawing author needs to submit a written letter or formal mail to MAT
 Journals stating reason for withdrawing along with penalty amount (which is Rs.
 2,500/- INR)
- 4. A formal mail/letter of manuscript withdrawal will be provided by MAT Journals

NOTE:

*Withdrawal of manuscripts is only allowed after withdrawal penalty has been fully paid to the MAT Journals by Author.

*Author can still continue to publish other manuscripts with MAT Journals provided they strictly follow the journal submission guidelines and publication ethics.
